There's a lot of history to experience in the Greater Binghamton area and beyond, we suggest checking out these highlights that make for a great family day trip. Start the with a trip back to yesteryear at the Bement-Billings Farmstead in Newark Valley. It's a living history museum interpreting domestic life and farm practices of the early 1800's. Visit the original Bement Farmhouse, a replica blacksmith shop, and more. And don't forget to stop and see the historic rail road depot nearby!
