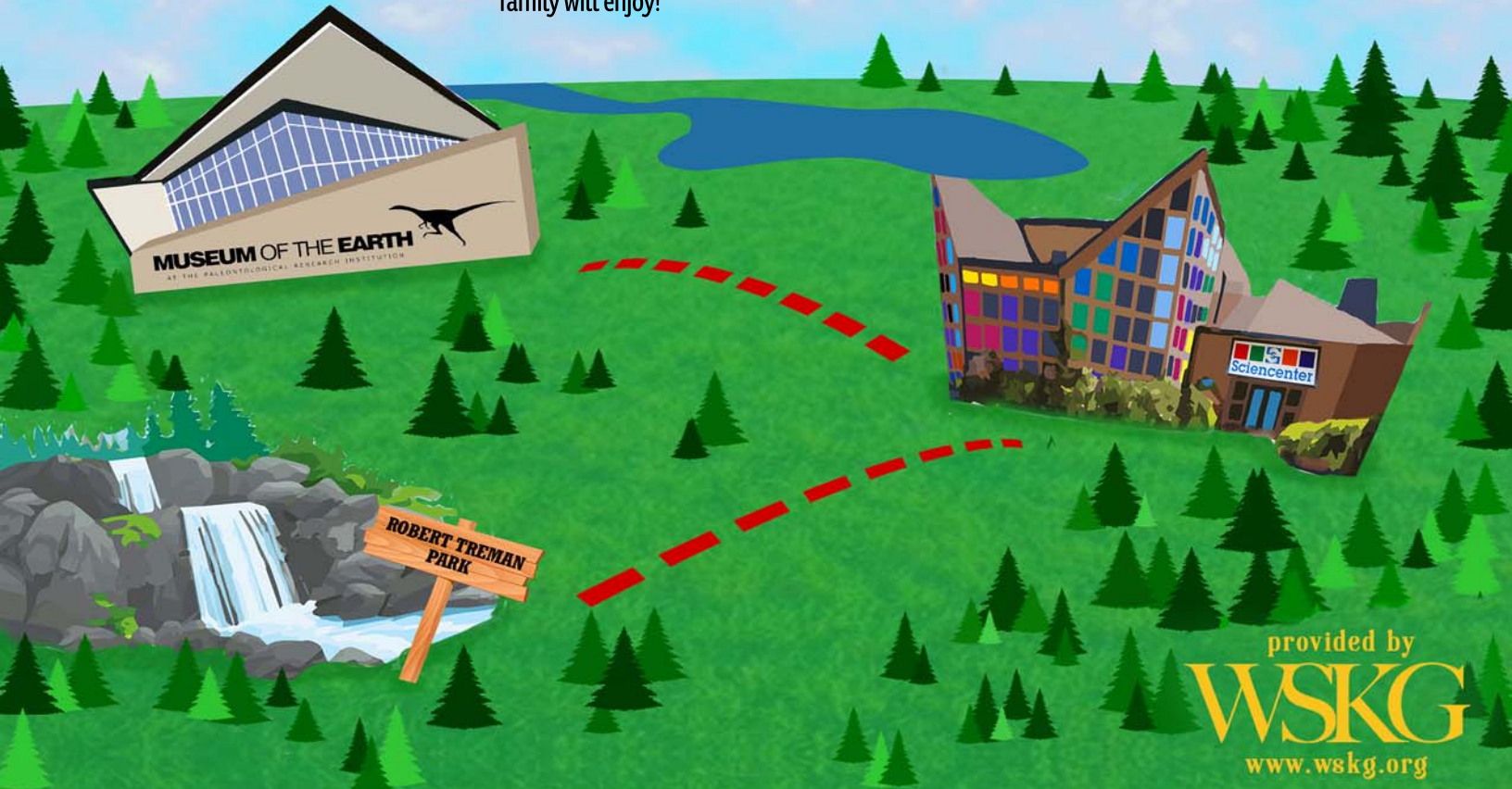


## Plan your day trip adventure, close to home! Ithaca/Tompkins County

Treman State Park is an area of wild beauty, with the Enfield Glen Gorge as its scenic highlight. There are miles of hiking trails where you can follow the gorge past 12 waterfalls including the stunning 115-foot Lucifer Falls. And if the weather's nice, have a swim in the park's lifeguarded area!
